

SALAT PRAYERS OBSERVED BEFORE MUHAMMAD

But the Jews and Christians "LOST" the Salat prayers.

﴿يَسْمِعُ أَفْئِنِّي لِرَبِّكَ وَأَسْجُدِي وَأَرْكَبِي مَعَ الرَّاكِعِينَ﴾

"O Mary, you shall obey your Lord, and you shall prostrate and bow down with those who bow down." (3: 43) ★

﴿قَالَ إِنِّي عَبْدُ اللَّهِ آتَانِيَ الْكِتَابَ وَجَعَلَنِي نَبِيًّا ﴿١﴾ وَجَعَلَنِي مُبَارَكًا ﴿٢﴾ أَيْنَ مَا كُنْتُ وَأَوْصَانِي بِالصَّلَاةِ وَالزَّكَاةِ مَا دُمْتُ حَيًّا ﴿٣﴾ وَبَرًّا ﴿٤﴾﴾

"(Jesus said,) God has made me blessed wherever I go, and He commanded me to observe the Salat prayers and Zakat charity for as long as I live." (19: 31)

﴿مُغْلَفٍ مِنْ بَعْدِهِمْ خَلْفًا أَضَاعُوا الصَّلَاةَ وَاتَّبَعُوا الشَّهْوَاتِ﴾

"Generations came thereafter who LOST the Salat prayers, and pursued their lusts." (19: 59)

There are remnants of the Salat prayers among the Jews, namely, the Samaritans, and the Christians (the Russian Orthodox Church). It is noteworthy that the Samaritan Jews have denounced the man-made commandments of Talmud, and decided to adhere to the word of God alone, i. e., Torah (see "The Myth of God Incarnate", Page 117).
