Returning Back to God

Most people believe in the existence of God. Among those who believe in God, there are those who worship Him daily, showing their thankfulness and gratitude for the blessings He has given them to live another day on earth.

However, Satan has won the minds of the some believers by influencing the innocent to commit the most blasphemous sin of all, idol-worship. believers will inevitably not worship Him alone. Even Satan told God that the majority of believers are unappreciative in their worship to God alone. Satan is the master of hypnosis that has influenced innocent believers and made them to drift away from God's grace.

[7:17] "I will come to them from before them, and from behind them, and from their right, and from their left, and You will find that most of them are unappreciative."

[15:39-42] He said, "My Lord, since You have willed that I go astray, I will surely entice them on earth; I will send them all astray. Except those among Your worshipers who are devoted absolutely to You alone." He said, "This is a law that is inviolable. You have no power over My servants. You only have power over the strayers who follow you."

When some believers are reminded to worship God alone and not to place any idols beside Him, they turn back on their heels and run away from the truth. The reason for this is answered in the verse below.

[18:57] Who are more evil than those who are reminded of their Lord's proofs, then disregard them, without realizing what they are doing. Consequently, we place shields on their hearts to prevent them from understanding it (the Quran), and deafness in their ears. Thus, no matter what you do to guide them, they can never ever be guided.

It is due to the strong ego that we all have that makes the majority turn against the path of God Almighty. The hearts and minds of the innocent believers have been polluted with false innovations and lies, falling into Satan's trap for so long, unable to break free. These poor souls have become spiritually disabled on the inside while their bodies are physically able. And because of the disability in their souls not giving the attention that it deserves, the physical body overtakes the soul making the person forget about God completely.

Most people would rather give more attention to their bodies than to themselves (i.e., the soul, the real person). They forget that this physical body, even if the person has built it big and strong, will one day become a useless piece of garment.

Myth of Intercession

The majority of believers in God believe that they are guided and they wishfully think that the gates of Heaven will be opened for them. They believe in their hearts that their idols such as Muhammad and Jesus will lead them to heaven, regardless of whether they have fulfilled their religious obligations or not. However, according to the Quran it is clear that no intercession is allowed in Submission unless it coincides with God's will. God's decision is final. [2:48, 123; 34:23, 43:86 etc.]

We learn from the Quran that Abraham, God's beloved servant and the founder of Islam (Submission), could not intercede on behalf of his own father [9:114]. Noah could not intercede on behalf of his son [11:46]. Muhammad could not intercede on behalf of his uncle [111:1-3] or relatives [9:80].

If Prophet Muhammad could not intercede on behalf of his uncle or relatives, what makes those who idolize him against his will believe that Muhammad will lead them to heaven? On the contrary, Muhammad will turn down most of his followers on the Day of Resurrection for idolizing him against his will.

[41:6] Say, "I am no more than a human being like you, who has been inspired that your god is one god. You shall be devoted to Him, and ask His forgiveness. Woe to the idol worshipers.

[25:55] Yet, they still set up beside GOD idols that cannot benefit them, nor harm them. Indeed, the disbeliever is an enemy of his Lord.

[46:5] Who is farther astray than those who idolize beside GOD idols that can never respond to them until the Day of Resurrection, and are totally unaware of their worship?

Muhammad himself did not know what would happen to him on the Day of Recompense. So how would he know what will happen to his so-called followers?

[46:9] Say, "I am not different from other messengers. I have no idea what will happen to me or to you. I only follow what is revealed to me. I am no more than a profound Warner."

Most people think that they will end up in heaven without any certainty or assurance. They think they are doing righteous works and will end up as the winners; little do they know the truth. Thus we have to examine ourselves.

[18:103-104] Say, "Shall I tell you who the worst losers are? They are the ones whose works in this life are totally astray, but they think that they are doing good."

[18:105] Such are the ones who disbelieved in the revelations of their Lord and in meeting Him. Therefore, their works are in vain; on the Day of Resurrection, they have no weight.

In conclusion, the majority of believers in God have been cheated by Satan, falling into his evil schemes of idolatry. Sadly, most people are unaware of their idolatry and that they are under Satan's spell. The time has now come to us with a chance to escape from Satan's prison and return back to our Creator, God Almighty and worshipping Him alone.

For this is where our true happiness lies, pleasing God and upholding His commandments and of course thanking Him in our prayers for the happiness and great joy that He has given to us all. God bless all those that truly believe in Him. God bless the world.

Follow Your Beak

16: 78. GOD brought you out of your mothers' bellies knowing nothing, and He gave you the hearing, the eyesight, and the brains, that you may be appreciative.

16:79. Do they not see the birds committed to fly in the atmosphere of the sky? None holds them up in the air except GOD. This should be (sufficient) proof for people who believe.

Homing pigeons and other birds can sense the Earth's magnetic field, an ability that helps them find their way home, even when home is hundreds of miles away. But how this magnetic sense works remains one of the most puzzling questions in sensory biology.

To learn the birds' secret, Gerta Fleissner, a neurobiologist at the University of Frankfurt in Germany, teamed up with physicists and other biologists. Their investigation focused on the skin of the upper beak—where the mysterious magnetic sense is thought to reside.

With powerful microscopes they identified three clusters of nerve endings on each side of the homing pigeon's beak, each cluster oriented along one of the bird's three perpendicular axes (beaktail, wing-wing, and back-belly). Inside the nerve cells they discovered something even more intriguing: two kinds of magnetic iron oxide—square platelets of maghemite and bullet-shaped particles of magnetite.

The investigators propose that an extremely delicate arrangement of those intracellular minerals constitutes the long-sought receptor for birds' magnetic sense.

Here's how they think it works:

Each pair of clusters (one on each side of the beak) is tuned to detect one of the three perpendicular spatial components of the Earth's magnetic field (north-south, east-west, and up-down). Depending on how closely a pair of clusters aligns with its magnetic-field component, the maghemite platelets in the clusters line up and magnetically attract the magnetite bullets.

The rearrangement of maghemite and magnetite in all three pairs of clusters triggers nerve impulses to the bird's brain, enabling the bird to sense the angle and intensity of the local magnetic field—and fly home. Fleissner located similar iron-bearing nerves in several other bird species, and she suspects all birds possess them.
